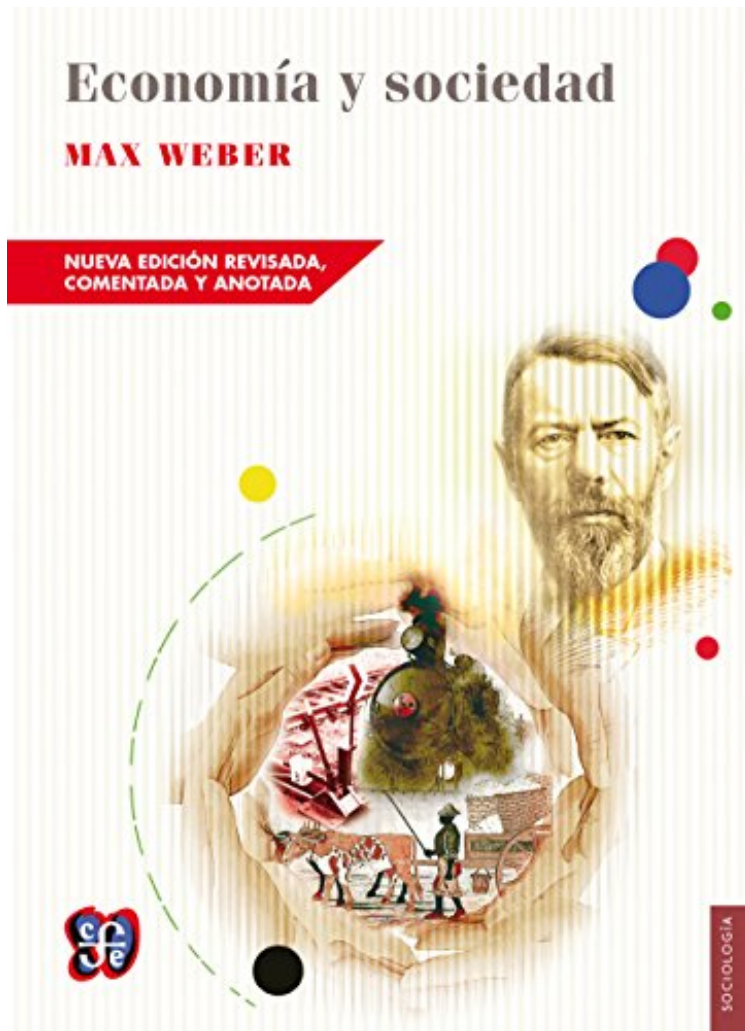

After completing his advanced studies, he became professor of economics first at Freiburg University and then at the University of Heidelberg.
