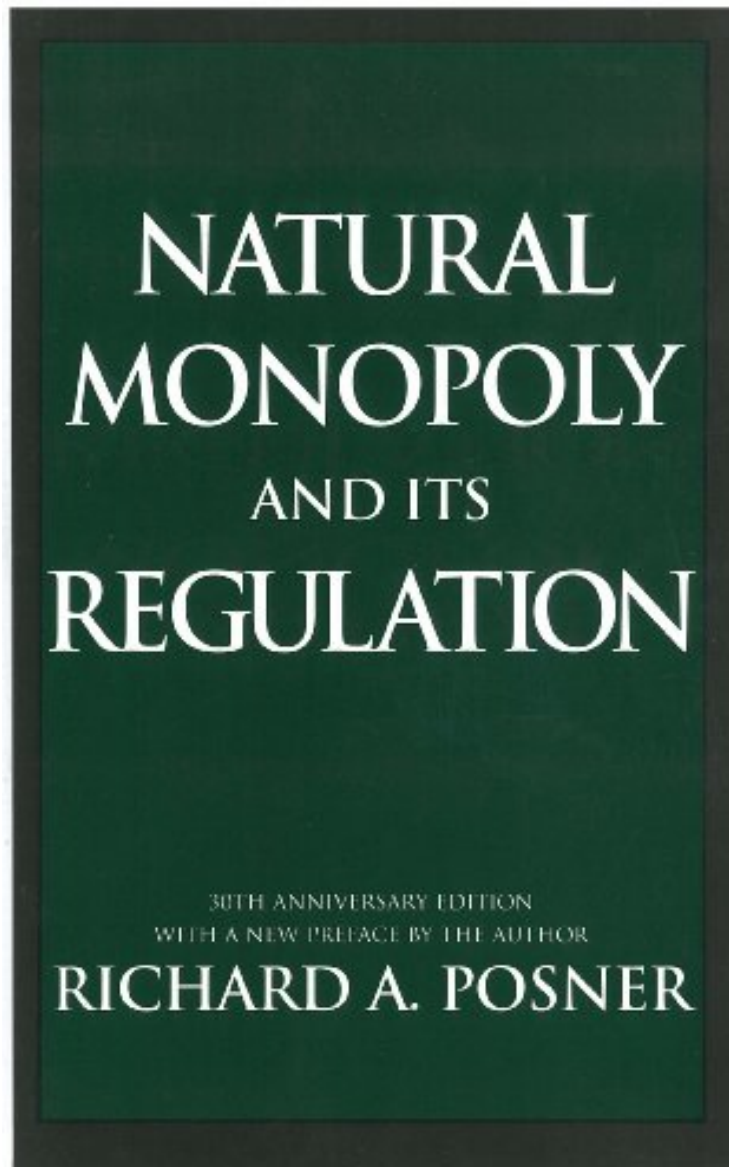

While I was able to follow the article, the kindle version has numerous textual errors including missing words

and spelling mistakes. It was quite sloppy in parts. This is not a major criticism but it is frustrating that you can't correct it like you would in a book with your pen! One other criticism which is more significant is that the endnotes are not linked, so you can move the cursor to it, click and be brought to the note and then hit the back button as I have been able to do on other kindle books with endnotes.
